

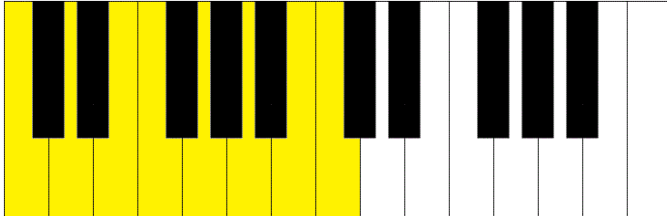


Scales

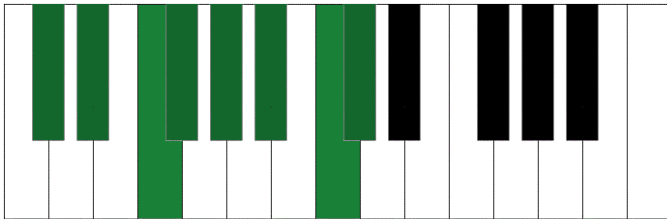

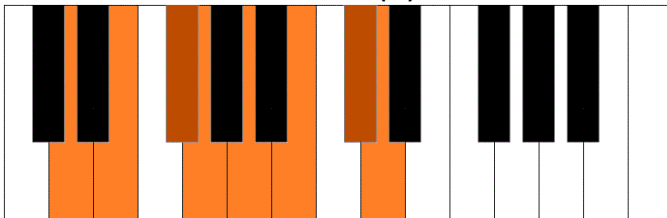

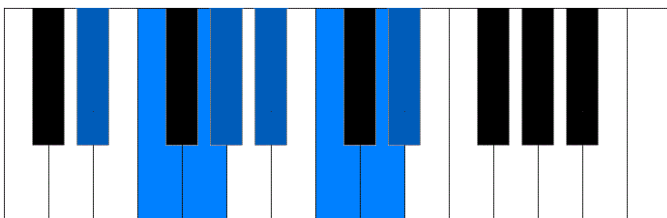
